This accreditation represents an independent measure of sustainability and best practices applied to the community across a number of measures. These measures are a reflection of the following six categories:



COMMUNITY: Create a vibrant, cohesive community that encourages an active healthy lifestyle. Engage with the local community and their facilities and embrace diversity.



MATERIALS: Encourage the use of recycled, reused, renewable materials to lessen the environmental impact.



WASTE: Aim to reduce waste sent to landfill by implementing waste management procedures and encouraging recycling.



WATER: Reduce use of potable water by implementing water reduction techniques and promoting water efficiency across the Canopy community.



ENERGY: Promote use of renewable resources and energy efficient appliances in an effort to reduce impact on the environment.



ECO SYSTEMS: Maintain healthy and resilient ecosystems based on natural processes and aim to enhance the environment through a number of ecological programs.
